

Work in progress XR3 homebuilt, 3 wheeled, turbo diesel powered vehicle. Started project with a set of plans December, 2012. Obtained title and license December 2019. Road testing now.

Kubota 4 cylinder, turbocharged industrial diesel (44.2 bhp at 3000rpm) engine mated to a 1969 VW beetle transmission. Frame and all other parts made from scratch. Body made from 1 inch thick ure-thane foam glued together with liquid nail and caulking gun, then shaped by hand before fiberglassing both sides.

I have a few U-tube videos of early test drives, without body.

Planning on taking it to Tubac Car Show in two weeks. Still needs troubleshooting work and cleaned up.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DIORAMA




On Saturday January 25 the car show starts at 10am, with cars parking on the driving range.




