



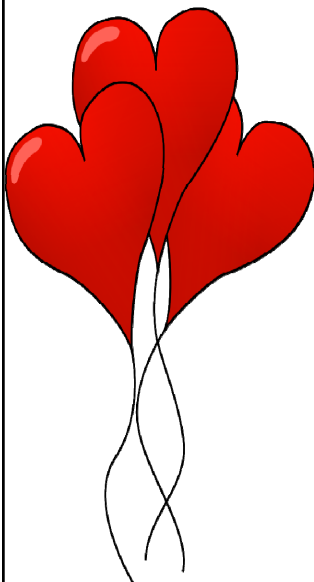

Our registration process had an added bonus: We were able to hear comments from those who entered the show. It's great to hear, "Congratulations on a grand weekend of cars and car people" or "As usual the Nuts did an outstanding job" or "Our BIG thanks for all your hard work on the great venue you put on". We received suggestions for following shows that will be reviewed and decisions made for possible changes in future shows.

taurant for the club holiday party.

Carol is checking on the price per plate. The board will vote on that when the price is given.

Past president John Murray gave some information on the Route 66 Fun Run leaving April 30th. The first night stay will be in Prescott AZ. The next two evenings will be in Williams AZ. It will be a beautiful scenic drive with lots of fun places to see along the way. Anyone interested on joining in on the trip can contact John ASAP. Many of the hotels are getting filled up.

Member Phil Layton announced that Dennis Gage was quite impressed with the car show and the surrounding areas of Tubac. Many of the cars he picked to film as he toured the show were also award winners picked by the judging staff. The show will be aired on his TV show March 28th.

The 50/50 drawing was won by new member Paul Micharls. He received \$63.00

It was mentioned that Carol will check on the possibility of the club becoming a 501C Tax exempt club for larger corporate donations to be made for the car show scholarship fund.

A much longer discussion of having the next car show at the Tubac Golf Resort or any other locations was covered along with other topics concerning the car show. It was decided that the club has to work smarter on putting on future car shows. Also to be covered are ways to have less volunteer workers as it is getting harder to get the needed

70 to 80 volunteers needed to put on the show. Also dropping the two vans that transport people to Tubac stores to shop would free up six workers for other areas.

Other topics included: The need to redo some of the car classes. Possibly adding a class just for club members so their cars would qualify for judging (only for this class). Marking class winner's cars and notifying owners to stay for the trophy presentations. Have more signage for people to know where spectators and car owners are to park. Many more areas will be looked into for future car shows.

After much discussions concerning the expense of having Dennis Gage here and the additional advertisement done this year it would be beneficial to have the car show at the Tubac Resort again next year. Jay Lucas made the motion and Art Mournian seconded the motion. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Rich Marsula and seconded by Jay Lucas for adjournment. Motion passed.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:43 a.m.



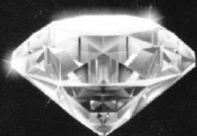

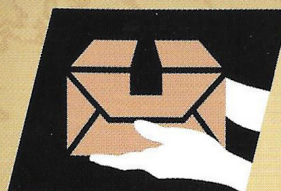
