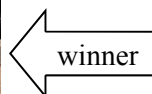
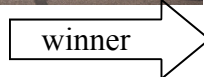
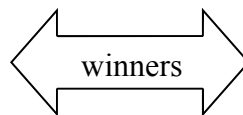
**CAR SHOW CAR SHOW CAR SHOW**

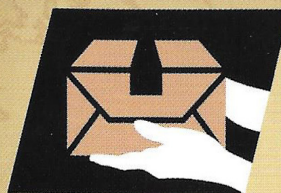
